Dear Brother Knights,

I'm hopeful for a good turnout of Brother Knights at our events in April, namely the Priest Appreciation Dinner and the Church Membership Drive. We need new and active members to ensure the continuation of our Council and Order.

Speaking of need, that's something which there is never a shortage of. On Palm Sunday, members of our Council participated with other Brother Knight's at St. John's Hospice in feeding the homeless, providing a hearty meal with a side of compassion to their clients. Thank you Men!

Continuing with needs, even though Lent is over, you can still donate food and money towards the Lenten food campaign "Forty Cans for Forty Days". We know that hunger never takes a holiday. Deputy Grand Knight Clint Snyder has been coordinating this project and we can expect a report on the Council's accomplishment next month. Great Job Clint!!

Finally, I want to update you Brothers on a topic we have been discussing at the recent meetings. If you haven't been able to attend a meeting this winter, then the subject of the real estate tax is new to you. The Home Association is looking at a tax bill from the City of \$13,457.62, which is an increase of approximately 10 times over previous years. We are engaging legal counsel to advise us on the appeal process. To date, the Home has made a payment of approximately 10% of the current bill and will set aside, in reserve, the balance due. Also, the Home will set aside a monthly allocation $(1/12^{th})$ of the anticipated real estate tax for the coming year. The purpose, of course, is to make sure that we have adequate funds available to pay the taxes should the property appraisal be justified.

The impact of the tax burden to the Council activities is yet to be determined, but any fund raising ideas you have and want to present are always welcome. Fundraising not only provides the financial support for our projects like Coats for Kids, but helps promote our Council and will help toward building membership.
