Dear Brother Knights,

I think it's safe to say that we can say good bye to the snow until next winter. In March, because of a snow storm, the Business meeting was postponed a week until March 9th and the Home meeting was subsequently pushed back a week. I was able to announce the change the night before via email. This brings me to a discussion we had at the meeting regarding the Banner. The Banner provides some insight of Council activities to our distant and homebound Brothers. We thoughtfully discussed its current publication schedule and distribution. Taking into consideration the cost and time it takes to print and mail the Banner, June will be the last edition that will be mailed to all Council Members. The Banner will still be published on the council web site and emailed to Council Members. However, if you don't have access to a computer or email, please contact me to continue to receive a hard copy of the Banner. Please see the notice in this edition of the Banner, which will continue appear until June, about the procedure to opt for a mailed copy and submitting your email address for a PDF version.

Another motion that was voted and approved was an addition distribution of \$150 to the parish schools for their tuition assistance programs. If you recall last fall, the donations to the parishes was reduced to \$1,200 per school. The additional donation this month represents the reinvestment to our parishes from the proceeds of the Keep Christ in Christmas magnet sales this past December.

We will be presenting our second \$500 RSVP award of the Fraternal Year to Mr. Adam Rosinski of St. Cecilia's parish, during a special session following the April Business Meeting. In the fall, we presented Mr. Louis Monica of Resurrection of Our Lord Parish with a \$500 RSVP award. The RSVP program is sponsored by Supreme for Councils to provide financial support to seminarians and religious as they study for their vocations. To encourage participation in the program, Supreme will provide a \$100 rebate back to the councils for each \$500 RSVP award presented (up to 5). I am proud and grateful of the stewardship of the Council's resources that enables us to make these donations.

April 11th and 12th there will be a Church Membership Drive at St. Cecilia Parish at all Masses followed by an informational meeting there on April 15th at 7pm in the Parish meeting room.
