

Brothers, our Worthy President Dan Donovan came across an article that explains what the Good of the Order is for. Supreme Chaplin Archbishop William E. Lori stated that in Robert's Rules of Order the Good of the Order is for "participants to offer comments or observations about the organization and its work. It is also time set aside for disciplinary matters involving fellow members." This article can be found in the Columbia on the Supreme Web site. So we will now call it "Prayer Requests."

The article to which Nick and Dan are referring can be found in the Columbian archives dated 11/01/2017. It may read to some that "Good of the Order" is replaced by "Prayer Requests."

Actually they are two separate sections: Prayer Requests followed by "Good of the Order."

Reference: "KofC The Method of Conducting Council Meetings" (10318 10/15). The Grand Knight asks if anyone knows of any ill brothers...etc., and we generally also ask for general prayer requests... "Before proceeding to the Good of the Order..."
