

→ Worthy Brothers,

I hope you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving and were able to spend time with your family and friends. December is a wonderful time for our faith as we celebrate the birth of Jesus. It can also be a very stressful time for those without Christ.

We are truly blessed to have our Catholic Faith and love of God to sustain our joy and peace while the world runs around aimlessly, stressed out, and unhappy without God. In this time of shopping, cleaning and cooking it is very important to remember Christ is Christmas.

Remember to be in the right attitude and pray always. Be especially thankful, because we as Americans have so much more material wealth than most others, and we as Catholics have so much more spiritually.

Advent begins Sunday, December 1 and the Immaculate Conception feast day is Sunday, December 8th. Although it is celebrated on Monday December 9 this year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation on Monday. Ember Days in Advent are December 18, 20 and 21 (Monday, Friday & Saturday).

I consider myself so blessed to be Catholic. We are blessed with so much joy and celebration, especially in December. I love taking advantage of these gifts, and especially that one really special gift of reconciliation. To me, after the Eucharist, Reconciliation is the best thing about being Catholic. We get to go to Confession! No one else has this wonderful gift.


Contrary to common misconception, abstinence from meat on Fridays throughout the year has *never* been abolished from Roman law. It was not abolished by Vatican II. It was not abolished by Pope Paul VI or Pope St. John Paul II. It was not abolished by the 1983 Code of Canon Law. It remains the universal law of the Latin Church — even if not everyone has to obey it.

Our Bishops here in the United States have given all of us in each diocese dispensation from this law. HOWEVER, Fridays are days of repentance and we are required to do something in lieu of not eating meat. Advent would be a great time to begin. Why not fast on Fridays in Advent, or maybe eat just one small meal? Maybe daily Mass each Friday or an extra rosary? I know of many "miracles" and answered prayers obtained by fasting and prayer.

Every Thanksgiving we have our collection for the Thanksgiving Gift Program and every Thanksgiving I am reminded of what a wonderful, thoughtful and generous council of Brother Knights we are! Thank you to all our generous brothers who gave to the Thanksgiving drive. Thank you to John McAleer for all his hard work and time with the mailings and visiting each parish.

John also did a fantastic job with the Football Sweeps program. THANK YOU, John!

Take time to help: I'm a great believer in the "power of one." The power of one person, the power of one minute, one hour, etc. Think of the exponential power of many doing a tiny bit as opposed to a few doing it all.
