ballot for voting. The member would open the email and immediately select his choice of candidate for each office and when completed, click "SUBMIT."

Food for Thought (Lectio Divina)

In the New testament John 21:15-18 (RSV 2nd edition), we read that after breakfast, Jesus asks Peter three times if Peter <u>loves</u> him.

In our Bible study I learned Jesus and Peter don't use the same Greek word for love. Ancient Greek has 8 words for our one English word <u>love.</u>
Curious about this, I looked up John 21:15 online in a Greek Interlinear Bible

(https://www.scripture4all.org/OnlineInterlinear/NTpdf/joh21.pdf).

The first time Jesus asks Peter if he loves (<u>Agape</u>) him? Peter answers that he does love (<u>Philia</u>) Jesus. Notice the difference in the kind of love each has. Jesus uses the word *Agape*, which is a total, unconditional, selfless love. However, Peter's word for love is *Philia* not *Agape*.

Philia is brotherly love or affection. Peter is telling Jesus he is very fond of him. He loves Jesus like a brother. Brotherly love is not a love to be taken lightly. As much as my brothers and I fought with each other growing up, God help anyone who came against any one of us. No matter our personal differences, all of us would immediately band together to protect and help the other.

We can bet Peter <u>wants</u> to love (*Agape*) Jesus, and is asking Jesus to help him *Agape*, but for now *Philia* is his best. No small thing, but not perfect love.

The question is then repeated a second time and answered, again expressing two vastly different kinds of love for each other.

But the third time is a showstopper.

Jesus asks Peter: "Simon, son of John, do you Philia me?"

Jesus does something so unexpected, so loving. It is very emotional moment for me.

The third question to Peter changes drastically. Jesus accepts Peter as he is right here, right now by changing his question from **agape** love to **philia** love.

Jesus asks Peter if he loves him and Peter answers "I'm very fond of you, like a brother."

Jesus asks a second time, "Peter, do you love me?"

Peter answers, "Yes, I am very fond of you. I have an incredibly special fondness for you. You are my brother." Jesus asks a third time, "Peter, son of John, Are you **fond** of me?"

"Because that is perfect for me. It thrills me to know you feel such great love for me."

Jesus asks you and me if we <u>Agape</u> him. We want to Agape, and we yearn for that perfect love, but for some, as hard as we try, we can't. We pray for it and beat ourselves up over it, and maybe like Peter when we are old, we will get it (Jn 21:18).

But at this moment, Jesus accepts our imperfect love as though it were perfect. He meets us as we are right now, and he tenderly tells us our love is the absolute best!

Jesus is electrified by your love and longs for you so much that he dies for you. Jesus is smiling at you right now, a loving God right next to you. Let him hug you. He knows us better than we know ourselves. We will grow little by little, day by day, hour by hour until we reach perfect love.



Stay safe, be healthy, don't worry and pray. Each and every one of you is in my daily prayers.
