Oceans of Mercy

My children and grandchildren have just left our mountain vacation retreat, and all is peacefully quiet; too quiet. The trees are swaying, dancing slowly in the whispering breeze. I'm sitting on the front deck overlooking the now lonely lawn. For a few brief seconds, the summer air is filled with echoes of years past and younger children. Trusting, loving children who find joy in just doing. I yearn for those lovely children and their happy, trusting love. Is God's love for me like that? Is he yearning for me? The yearning, the love I now feel is just a glimpse of God's love for me.

In Luke 15 we read about the forgiving father. The son completely rejects his father and wastes a fortune gratifying his earthly desires. He then comes to his senses, and he wants to go home. But he does not expect his father to welcome him back into the family. He is willing to labor as a lowly hired servant. He takes the time to sit down and draft an eloquent apology, but never gets the chance to recite it. His father sees him coming in the distance, runs to him and overwhelms him with love, with kisses and hugs. Not what the son expected.

So, yes God yearns for you and me more than we know. His mercy is unbounding – hard for us to comprehend. But Jesus expects us to treat others the same as we want to be treated. "Then Peter came up and said to Him "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him?' Jesus' answer is astounding. We are to forgive an infinitely number of times, or we are not forgiven.

We can be the worst sinner and ask in earnest for God to forgive us, and He does – probably before we finished asking! What jumps out at me in Jesus' answer is the number of times I am required to forgive. If I don't forgive offenses against me infinitely, I will pay dearly. In His next example, Jesus tells us that it will be like the king who forgave his servant 10,000 talents (\$232.8 billion), but then that same servant goes out and punishes a fellow servant who owes him 100 denarii (\$40). So how many times have I been forgiven 232 billion dollars' worth of sin, but refused to forgive my brother the \$40 he owes me? Jesus says if justice is our measure, we will be measured with justice. Mercy is replaced by Justice, and we will be thrown into frustration, pain and torment until the debt is fully paid!

"For as you judge, so will you be judged, and the measure with which you measure will be measured out to you." (Mt 7:2)

Mercy or Justice? Which do I want? I receive forgiveness "as" I forgive others –
