From The Lecturer



Do not store treasure on earth... store treasure in Heaven (Mt 6:19-20)

In Sunday's, November 1, 2020 Gospel (Matthew 5:1-12a), Jesus teaches the Beatitudes. The first of which is blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

An online thesaurus list of synonyms for blessed are: fortunate, happy, lucky, to be envied, etc. So we can say happy are those, or how fortunate, how lucky are those who are poor in spirit.

What does "poor in spirit" mean? I've tried to figure that out over the years listening to many sermons and reading how others define "spirit" in the context of that

Beatitude. The definition I like is *being detached from the things of the world*. The wealthiest person in the world can be poor in spirit if not attached to worldly things. One may have billions of dollars but doesn't really care about the money or the things it can buy, because he is seeking God. How happy he is, because he has discovered that material things are absolutely worthless in the big picture. Our real treasure much better than any earthly wealth is Heaven. When you consider that eternal life is forever, infinity; what good is it to desire material things that we only enjoy for a very short time here on Earth? It's like enjoying everything you want for one minute compared to an 80 year lifetime. What fun is that?

How happy we would be craving God and working towards eternal life instead of killing ourselves going after worldly things. Eternal life is permanent. Our time here on earth is temporary. How happy, how fortunate, how lucky are those who live their life desiring and working towards God & eternal life, they are already living in heaven and they are full of joy here on earth looking forward to eternal bliss.
