
## From The Lecturer

I started this month's message during a break while attending our yearly Malvern Retreat via ZOOM on Saturday, January 23, 2021.

It is now that time during Retreat when those physically attending can go to Confession. We at home on Zoom were suggested to reflect during this time. I've been keeping notes and would like to share them with you as my reflection.

At the opening of the retreat, Father Jim McQuinn, Rector, said that our emotions are not right or wrong – It's what you do with them. I don't know if it was intended, but this beautifully leads us to the next part.

Father Dan Arechabala (St. Agnes, West Chester) our Retreat Master posed this: Did you ever get a "God-high" then come down to "reality" (supposed reality)? We need daily scripture to let God speak to us and to learn more about him to love him.



Deacon Pat Diamond turned me on to an excellent way to experience daily scripture. It's a daily podcast from Father Mike Schmitz and Ascension Press called "The Bible in a Year". If you are unfamiliar with podcasts, just download any podcast app (I use Google podcasts from the Google Play Store and subscribe to Father Schmitz's podcast. We need Scripture for TRUTH and reflection.

Father Dan reminded us that people in today's culture value Money more than life. We idolize money, honor, power, and pleasure over God. How many hours in a day do we spend doing what we want to do rather than what God wants? We forget that Jesus gives us far more than we can perceive. For our own happiness and fulfillment, we are encouraged

to spend time with God in a quiet place to hear His voice and discern what it is that He wants us to do.

St. Thomas Aquinas said that four typical substitutes for God are wealth, honor, power, and pleasure. Sensing the void within, we attempt to fill it up with some combination of these four things. Something to ponder before Confession.

There was a question-and-answer session and I asked how do we "Pray always" in a typical day in today's world? The answer was long, but I will summarize: it is striving to live each day with Christ as our Center. Take Him from the periphery of our circle of life and bring him to the center.

If it's hard or you are not sure how, start each morning with just a few seconds of prayer "Jesus I trust in you, Jesus I trust in you." Bring Christ to mind often. Add more prayer and actions as you grow. I like using the 'Pray' section of the Relevant Radio App. There's also "The Bible in a Year" podcast and/or maybe a rosary. Come back to prayer throughout the day. Think how Jesus would handle each task of the day. Soon your life will be Christ-centered with much joy and satisfaction as God opens many doors and ways to be a loving Christian.
