He asked the question, "If you could have any superpower, you wanted what would you choose?"



Father Mike then asked if you would use that power - because you would still be you. He explained the details of additional superpowers that would be needed to perform your superpower. For example, one might ask to be granted to fly at the speed of light. Your present body could not stand the friction, etc. to travel at that speed, so you would need another superpower to withstand everything physically happening to your body during flight. Your mind would have to have another superpower to think faster than the speed of light to avoid collisions, etc. For any superpower you may wish you are going to need to think through the details of what that entails. But even after you have everything in place, would you use this power? You'd have the ability, you would be capable, but you would still be you.

What about the seven superpowers you already possess? The supernatural powers of Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Fear of the Lord, and Piety. Since Confirmation you have had each of these, but have we ever used them? One might ask for the power to heal the sick, "God, If you would give me the gift of healing, I would love to go to people who are hurt and broken and be able to extend your healing into their lives." Okay, when was the last time you visited a nursing home? When was the last time you visited someone, you already love who was in the hospital or when they were sick?



To illustrate this, Father Mike told us a true story about a friend of his driving to a speaking engagement from Minnesota to Wisconsin. Nick came upon an accident and people where dangerously squeezing by to get around it. Where you or I might keep going and relieved once we got by the accident and on time for our engagement, Nick stopped and ran out with only his phone for a flashlight and started directing traffic. A Truck stopped and the driver

yelled to him, "Son – Do you want a reflective vest? And he took it. A little later on a State Trooper stopped and gave him a bigger flashlight and some traffic cones. Nick started with only the flashlight on his phone and a willingness to help, but because he used the gifts he had, he was given more gifts.

Jesus says to those who have, more will be given. In other words, those who have and use what gifts they have been given, more will be given to them. Start with what you have right now, and you will be given whatever else is needed. We don't even use what little we have now. How am I using the gifts now for the Kingdom? Not only spiritual gifts, but all gifts. It's not about us. It is not about power, ability..., not about gifts. Ultimately, it's about the relationship. Jesus promised He would not leave us orphans. He didn't leave us alone. He sent each one of us the Holy Spirit to dwell in our hearts. Jesus says, whatever we ask in His name, we will receive – What He is saying is If you live in My will, if you live in relationship with Me, if what you are asking for is what is in My heart to give, then absolutely I will answer everyone of your prayers. And how do we know how to live that way unless we are living in relationship with Him?

Start with the gifts you have and take the leap of faith trusting God will give you more.


