Think Hope

Since clipping the wings of Governor Wolf through the successful "Vote Yes" campaign, we have been approached by many local conservatives asking, "What's next?". We intend to tell you what's next at:

In one hour we will take you through the steps that are necessary to effect change in our local area. You will hear from the Chief Counsel at **Pennsylvania Family Institute** on two pressing issues: school choice and abortion, including a Pennsylvania Supreme Court case brought on by the abortion industry that is asking taxpayers to fund abortion and to invent a "right to abortion" in our longstanding Pennsylvania Constitution.

You will also hear from the Chief Strategist at **Commonwealth Foundation**. CF will discuss how the unlikely "Vote Yes" ballot initiative was won. That effort helped mobilize citizens to constitutionally rein in Governor Wolf after he abused his emergency powers during COVID-19. CF will also share what you can do to get more involved.

Lecturer's Message November 2021

November is the Month of the Holy Souls. November 2 is All Souls Day, but we remember them in a special way throughout the month.

"Eternal Rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine them. May all the souls of the Faithful Departed rest in peace. Amen."

Many times, I add, "...especially Priests, Religious and all those who have no one to pray for them."

Is it possible we are praying for ourselves also? We are. Someday we will be, hopefully, one of those souls in Purgatory. I like to think our own prayers will be for us when we are there, since there is no "time" (

when we are there, since there is no "time" (no future, no past) in the afterlife.

We can ask the souls in Purgatory to pray for us. St Thomas Aquinas believes that the souls in Purgatory can not pray for us on earth (The Church Militant), but St. Robert Bellarmine thinks they can. The Church has not ruled definitively on this matter. One thing is for certain, we can pray for the souls in Purgatory (The Church Suffering), and they will remember you helped them into Heaven. Once in Heaven (the Church Triumphant), they can and will pray for you.


Even though we are forgiven our sins in Confession there is still the temporal aspect that must be accounted for. "Every sin, even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory. This purification frees one from what is called the **'temporal punishment'** of sin. (CCC 1472).

We can gain freedom from temporal punishment right now here on Earth, by obtaining Plenary indulgences. The Enchiridion of Indulgences or Manual of Indulgences is a handbook

that explains what indulgences are and provides the many devotional prayers associated with them. manual of indulgences pdf Download (404manual.com)

Remember we are still in the year of St. Joseph until December 8, 2021 with special indulgences we may gain for ourselves and others. You can learn all the details of the plenary indulgence by reading the full Decree from the Vatican: Pope Francis proclaims "Year of St Joseph" - Vatican News.
