



Pope Francis announced the Year of Saint Joseph to run from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021. On the same day, the Apostolic Penitentiary announced a special Plenary indulgence for the Year of St. Joseph. What a fantastic



opportunity to allow St. Joseph to bring us closer to God.

I don't know about you, but I want to do everything possible to eliminate my time in Purgatory (assuming I am worthy enough to gain Purgatory).


Even though we are forgiven our sins in Confession there is still the temporal aspect that has to be accounted for. "every sin, even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory. This purification frees one from what is called the 'temporal punishment' of sin. (CCC 1472).

We can gain freedom from temporal punishment right now here on Earth, by obtaining Plenary indulgences. The Enchiridion of Indulgences or Manual of Indulgences is a handbook explaining what indulgences are and provides many devotional prayers associated with them. (http://so.404manual.com/search.php?utm_source=manual%20of%20indulgences%20pdf) But now we can add greater opportunity for Plenary Indulgences with Pope Francis' special gift to us of the Year of St. Joseph.

- Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's prayer or take part in a Spiritual Retreat with meditation on St. Joseph.
- Perform a spiritual or corporal act of mercy following St. Joseph's example.
- Families or engaged couples can recite the Rosary together. (Relevant Radio Family Rosary Across America, 8 P. M. daily 640AM or "Facebook Watch")
- Entrust your daily work to St. Joseph or ask St. Joseph's intercession for the unemployed to find dignifying work.
- Recite the Litany of St. Joseph or any other prayer to St. Joseph for the persecuted church and relief of all Christians suffering from persecution.
