God Always Answers Everyone's Prayer

When you read this, we will be more than halfway through Lent. Still not too late to offer something up. God always meets you right where you are on your road to holiness. Maybe do a small act of charity each day. Bring your neighbor's empty trash cans in, Smile and acknowledge passers-by when out walking, or say an extra prayer for the souls in Purgatory. When we make a "decision" to



pray we think it's something we started on our own. But it wasn't our decision to begin with. God initiated or started the conversation, our prayer, and we are responding. He loves you and loves hearing your voice. Sure, God knows everything. He knows beforehand for what you are going to ask or pray, but He wants to hear your lovely voice or prayers asking Him.

Many do not believe in prayer. They complain God never answers their prayers. But God in his loving kindness will always give you what you <u>need</u>. He answers every prayer with what is <u>best</u> for you.

In Matthew Chapter 7 when Jesus is teaching us the Beatitudes, (Some synonyms for beatitude: ecstasy, euphoria, exultation, high), Jesus teaches, "⁷Ask, and it will be given to you... ⁸For everyone who asks receives..." Stop and reread that. Pause and think about what Jesus is telling us here. Every one of us **receives** an answer! The answer may not be what we expected, but what we needed. Jesus goes on to teach us, "¹¹If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

"HOW MUCH MORE!" We often forget the super power we have in the goodness, mercy, and love of our wonderful Father in heaven. As I'm writing this in mid-March, I suddenly remember I want to call the specialist's office later today to try and reschedule an earlier appointment with another doctor. My regular doctor can't see me until May 16. I get a powerful urge to call right now. The receptionist found a cancelation for my regular doctor for tomorrow! Wow! What an affirmation! Thank You Lord!

God wants you to know that in His loving care for you, He is with you in every detail of your day. Many will put off God's helping us in simple, every-day things as pure happenstance, but I'm convinced otherwise. They happen too often and just at the right moments. There are no coincidences! Thank you, Lord God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for your kindness, goodness, and help!


