I'm sitting on the third-floor deck of a beach-front Sea Isle City rental facing the vast expanse of the Atlantic Ocean.

I'm stumped.

I have no idea what to write about. Usually there are 4 or 5 topics swimming around in my brain. I'm way late this month. Usually this is finished and sent to publication around the 15th of each month.

I went back and looked over my past submissions for some ideas and was surprised at what I read. I couldn't have written that. Or that. Where did those words come from? Usually, I start writing and the piece takes on a life of its own. The ideas pop, the words flow, and suddenly it is finished. I may have said this before, but these messages are not from me. They can't be. I'm not that gifted. I'm just a conduit through whom the words flow.

I'm not out here alone. Across the porch, my older sister Clare and her husband Willie sit enjoying the cool ocean breeze and sun. Will had a stroke a few years back and then two more this year. He is paralyzed on one side. He doesn't speak and can barely drag along with help from Clare or one of us siblings. It took a lot of cajoling and threats to get Will to come along this year, but Clare was determined not to miss our 'down-na-shore' annual family get-together another year. I'm amazed at the suffering that Clare endures taking care of Willie. But she doesn't see it as a chore or suffering. She has many moments of frustration and pain but is quick to point out what Willie must be enduring. She dotes on him and caters to his every need. I wonder if I would be the same in her place. Does she see this as a gift from God?

Behind Willie and Clare is the ocean. I'm reminded of God's vast ocean of mercy and love for us. It is overwhelming. God is chasing us even as we run from him. I for one certainly do not deserve God's goodness and love. But as Saint Paul exhorts, "Thanks be to the Lord Jesus Christ through whom we obtain all that God gives us."
