Again, thanks to all who have taken their time to volunteer at events or who have attended them. Our support has been greatly appreciated.

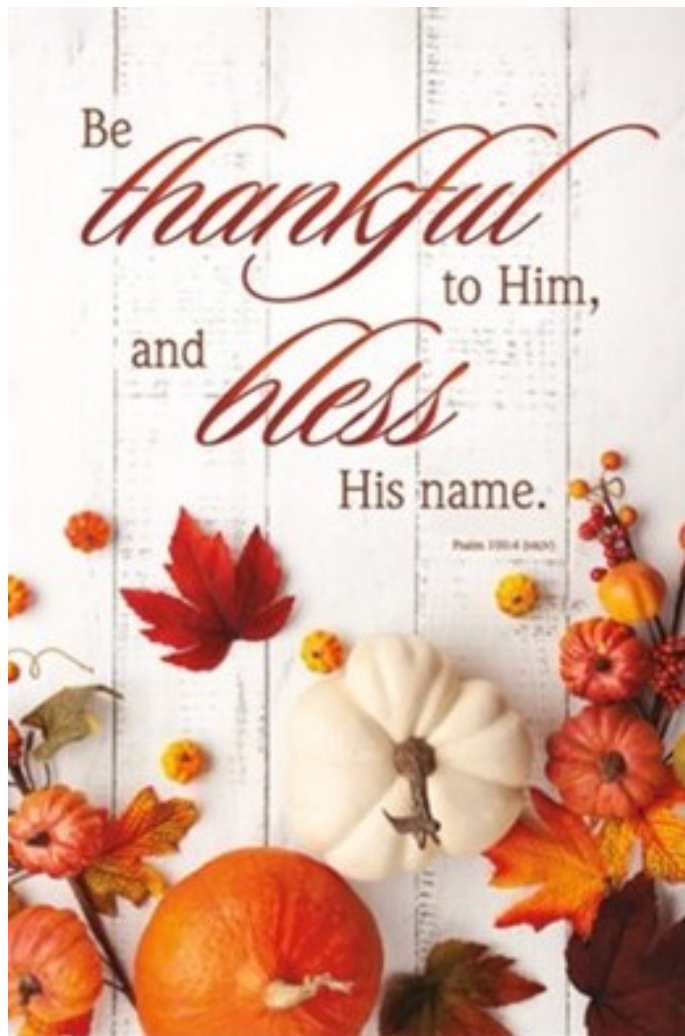
You should have received you letter concerning the Thanksgiving Teas Baskets. If you have not, please let me know. Please be generous. The money raised helps our neighbors in need.

You are Very Important to God

At Mass on Friday, October 14, 2022 Deacon Pat Diamond's homily went straight home to my heart and reminded me again of the kindness and love of our heavenly Father.



Quoted below is Deacon Pat's homily for Friday of the 28th week in Ordinary Time (Gospel: Luke 12:1-7).

In today's gospel passage, Jesus covers quite a few items. But I would like to concentrate on just two. The first deals with the issue of hypocrisy.

In the ancient world, a hypocrite was an actor, someone who was merely playing a role as in a theatrical production. Thus, the meaning came to describe someone who was simply acting a part, who was neither authentic nor genuine. Jesus is proclaiming that God would rather deal with someone who was a blunt, honest sinner than someone who merely put on an act of goodness.

The second issue has to do with the value of each individual person. God's care for His children is the most detailed of all. To God we are never lost in a crowd. Not even a sparrow which seems so insignificant when being purchased for a very small amount is forgotten by God. The very hairs of our head have been numbered by God. (I realize that can be a sore point for some people, nevertheless!)

Some Jews were so impressed by the individual care by God that it was said that they believed that every blade of grass had a guardian angel. With that level of faith, none of us needs to harbor any fears, confident in the belief and willing to eagerly proclaim that "God truly cares for me."
