



God Reveals Himself Gradually in Stages



It endlessly amazes me how God inspires us by tying together little everyday things, thoughts, words, etc. to form or confirm a teaching, prayer, idea, or new thought.

I decided earlier today to organize my notes on "The Catechism in a Year." It is day 17 and the margins of my Catechism are full of scribbled notes all over the place with no real order. In the back of my mind, I'm also thinking it's getting late into the month and I need to get started on the Lecturers' message for The Banner newsletter.

As I'm putting my notes in order, I see a remarkable connection from the Catechism to an RCIA article I have been trying to complete; writing, rewriting, and rewriting repeatedly always towards a dead end. I'm slow to get things, but this time God slapped me on the head and 'suddenly' I got it! I use the 'suddenly' tongue-in-cheek. This can also be a great topic for the newsletter. It might help someone out there. It also reveals why it takes me so long to learn.

Paragraph 54 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, CCC 54 and CCC 122 talk about God's divine Revelation to us. God wants you and me to move closer to Him and what better way than to help us get to know him. He first revealed himself to our first parents. Even after they sinned, He didn't abandon us. He again manifests Himself after the flood through a covenant (*promise, treaty*) with Noah, then again with Abraham. After this God forms the people of Israel and the final revelation, the mediator and fullness of all revelation is the Christ Jesus.

God's divine Revelation occurred in <u>stages gradually</u> over thousands of years. CCC 65 teaches there will be no further divine Revelation after Christ. Yet even if Revelation is already complete, it has not been made completely explicit. It remains for Christian faith <u>gradually</u> to grasp its full significance over the course of the centuries." (CCC 66). So, if God reveals to far greater minds in stages and gradually, I understand why it takes me so long. The key points here are "<u>gradually</u>" and "in <u>stages</u>." Why can't God just infuse us all with complete knowledge and understanding of Him all at once?

That way we could all be fully in love with God, desire nothing more and exist in ecstatic joy and fulfillment in union with Him. Oh, wait! That's coming.

It makes perfect sense for God to reveal Himself <u>gradually</u> and in <u>stages</u>. Think of it this way. Can a first grader understand eighth-grade instruction?

God had to start somewhere. Imagine you were able to go back in time and bring someone from the 4th or 5th century forward to 2023. They would probably die of cultural shock at the sight of an automobile, no less an airplane or space travel. The same with Revelation.

God had to meet the human race where they were in their time, whatever time period. He had to meet them in their culture. Our first parents, Abraham, Moses, Noah all met God based on their culture and customs of the period in which they lived. And we humans need time to think about, absorb, and accept new ideas.

Otherwise, it would be like the 21st Century technology and culture crushing down on a 4th century person. Thus, the <u>gradual</u> Revelation in <u>stages</u>.

CCC 122 explains the economy of the Old Testament books, but it can apply to all of God's Revelation: "Even though they contain matters imperfect and provisional *(exists for the time being, but may possibly change later)*, the books of the Old Testament bear witness to the whole divine pedagogy *(Teaching, education, training)* of God's saving love."

To be understood by humans, God's Revelation had to be in human language, instructed in their way of living and thinking (provisional), and at their level of understanding (First Graders).

I think this still applies today for each one of us. It is with joy and fulfillment that we learn a little bit step-by-step, building on each preceding step to higher levels of understanding to know, love, and serve God.

You and I can move closer to God and fall more in love with him by getting to know Him. Somedays more than others, gradually, in stages!
