My Brother Knights,





Do You Choose Life or Death?

In the Profession of Faith, we pray "I believe in life everlasting."

Once we die physically, once our soul separates from our human body, our chance of accepting or rejecting God is done.



That's it. Caput! Finished! Done! We had our entire life up to the last second to accept God and now it's gone.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 1021 tells us we will be rewarded <u>immediately</u> after death in accordance with our works and faith.

Saint Paul in 1 Corinthians 15:52 tells us it will be in an instant, in the twinkling of an eye. We die and, in a flash, instantly, we are before God.

You're lying in a bed sleeping or thinking about whatever and suddenly there before you are God and your particular judgement.

CCC 1022 reads: "Each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul *at the very moment of his death*, in a '*particular*' judgement..." (vs the last judgement) "...that refers..." (compares) "...his life to Christ: either into the blessedness of heaven—through purification or immediately,--or immediate and everlasting damnation."

We get what we have chosen. If we have said "yes" to God's will, we get Him, if not, we don't. It's what we choose. Do we choose God or anything other than God? We need to choose God over our desires (food, sex, drink, TV, etc.)

At our 'particular judgement' we will <u>not</u> be compared to our neighbor or anyone else (Some say "I'm not that bad, I'm no Hitler" or "Compared to so-and-so I'm a saint"). Our life will be compared to Christ, no one else.

What if today is your last day on earth? One of these days it will be. How would you live? What would you need to do? In the Book *"Imitation of Christ"*, Thomas Kempis exhorts: "If you aren't fit to face death today, it's very unlikely you will be tomorrow..."

We decide. We choose life or death. God wants you to choose life. He loves you. You were created for heaven.

When we pray the Hail Mary, we ask the Mother of God to intercede for us "at the hour of our death." CCC 1014.
