

Back in May (Tuesday, May 23 to be exact), I awoke at 3:50 A.M. and unable to get back to sleep I went downstairs and watched "Day 143 of Fr. Mike Schmitz's

Most of what follows is Father Mike with some interjection by me.

Father Mike encourages us to think about our death. Something we would look forward to if we truly understood what death is. Death is simply just passing from one form to another. At the moment of death, our soul separates from our body and immediately we are before God for our particular judgement. We are present with total love, mercy, kindness, and goodness. At that moment we receive our eternal recompense, we get what we have chosen.

Father Mike says it would be a great spiritual practice for us to imagine our death on a regular basis. That is to imagine the moment after our death when we come before God, face to face. What does his face look like as He looks up and sees us? What do we see as His gaze rests upon us and our gaze rests upon Him?

Is the look upon God's face one of pure joy?
Is the Lord's look one of absolute thankfulness? Praise for you?
Is He looking at you with good fatherly pride and the fact that you done it?
Can He look at us with joy as we stand before him at the moment after our death and he says to us, well done good and faithful servant. Come receive your Master's Joy. Enter into your Master's Joy."

Or do We Stand face to face with God when he looks up and sees us and know us as we are and loves us so deeply.

But will there be pain in his face?

Will there be sorrow on his face as He looks at us and sees what we've chosen? As we stand before God in his goodness, and his beauty, and his love, will He look at us and say, "Oh, I know that's what you've chosen. You've chosen not me."

When I look upon him and realize I've chosen not him.

I had a whole life. I had an entire life to choose him, and I didn't.

I had an entire life to say yes to God my father, God my savior, God the Holy Spirit who dwells in me through baptism and Confirmation.

Every time I pray and ask the father for the holy spirit in Jesus' name, he gives it. I had all those chances, all those chances to just simply say, "I'm sorry, please father help me," and I didn't.

And we'll look upon the Father's face, look upon the face of our judge Jesus Christ, and His face will be sad, sorrowful, grieved,

and He will walk away, we will never enter his presence ever, ever again.

Never to gaze upon goodness ever again.

Never to experience love ever again.

It's worth it. It's worth meditating on our death.
It's worth meditating on that moment right after our death.
Will we stand before God, and He'll break into a smile of joy?
Well done - Through all the weakness, and all the pain, and all the suffering, you realize it's all worth it.

I think it was Saint Teresa of Avila who said, "At the end of our life when we get to heaven, even with the most miserable, most horrible of our lives; a most painful and suffering-filled life will seem like a night in a bad Motel."

I hope so, I hope so.

Or will we stand before the Lord and see that sorrow in his eyes and feel nothing but regret? Feel nothing but resentment towards him? We kind of know that we, when we walk away, will never again see goodness?

We should pray that we have the grace of final perseverance. It's one of the things we pray for when we pray the Hail Mary. We pray, "Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death." That grace with final perseverance is necessary for all of us. Maybe pray three 'Hail Marys' every day that we have a priest with us at our death.

To be able to close our eyes and peacefully say, "Amen," eagerly seeking our encounter with our greatest joy, Our Lord and our particular judgement.
