
—— From the Desk of the Grand Knight

---- Lecture Message

Can I Be Wealthy AND Still Get to Heaven?

Paragraph 2544 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church is the most challenging and convicting paragraph for many. We are urged by Jesus in Lk 14:33 and Mk 8:35 to take what is dearest to us, (plans, people, things, power, money...) and kiss it good-bye. He enjoins His disciples to prefer Him to everything and everyone. He bids them "renounce all that they have" for His sake and that of the Gospel.

The last sentence in Paragraph 2544 reads "The precept of detachment from riches is obligatory for entrance into the kingdom of heaven." We all know about the young rich man in Mt. 19:16-30 who went away sad when Jesus told him to chuck it all and give to the poor if he wanted perfection.



So, what's the deal here? Can I be wealthy and still

get to heaven? What does it mean to be wealthy? To someone who has lost everything and living on the streets, wealth is having a steady job with a roof over her head and food for the kids. To the guy with a steady job that allows him a home and support for his family, barely getting by paycheck to paycheck, wealth is a paid-off mortgage and a bigger paycheck. And so on. The further up the wealth ladder we go there is still something lacking.

I don't think there's a number or situation to define wealth. Most Americans are considered extremely wealthy by poorer nations. Wealth is subjective. But wealth is not the issue. The problem is attachment. "Detachment from riches is obligatory for entrance into the Kingdom of Heaven." (CCC 2544). Attachment to anything not of God.

We need to constantly mature in our love for God. "Blessed are the poor in spirit." (Mt. 5:3) Spirit being what is in our heart. What we love the most. What we are 'attached' to or idolize. Pray constantly. Seek God, talk with God. Ask God to transform our heart to desire Him over everything else. He is our only treasure.

"But I don't <u>want</u> to desire God over things... at least not yet." Then pray for the desire to want to 'want to.' God is waiting for you. God wants you more than you know. And you can't embarrass Him. God already knows what's in your heart, but He wants to reveal it to you. Mr. Rogers used to say, "If it is mentionable, it's manageable."

We think God just tolerates us, when actually, He hugely loves us. When we pray it isn't us starting it: God initiates, and we respond! God began the dialog, not me. When I pray, I'm responding to God's initial call to me.

Give Him permission to love you. Talk with him...now.
