Dear Brothers:

As we enter the month of February, we enter into the holy season of Lent. This begins Ash Wednesday, February 14th. As a reminder this is a day of fast and abstinence. That it also falls on the feast of St. Valentine will make the fast and abstinence even more meaningful.



As I said last month, I would have information concerning the council's activities during the year 2023. While I do not have the final numbers yet, I am proud to report that the members of this Council donated nearly **1,000 hours of service** to our parishes and communities last year. We also raised nearly **\$3,900 in charitable donations** and as I said donated about **3,500 pounds of food** to Catholic Social Services. Speaking of my successor, elections will be held in June. All offices are open, and any thirddegree member is eligible to run for any office. If anyone is interested in running, please reach out to me or any officer of the Council.

The Council is still three members short of meeting its membership goal for the fraternal year. All members are encouraged to recruit new members. I just heard of a Council in South Philadelphia that in the last two months recruited 11 new members, with eight of them being in their 20s. So it's not impossible to find men out there interested.



# Trust in the Lord

I'm sitting here dreadfully indecisive, staring at a blank sheet of paper ready to write. Normally somewhere around the 12<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month I read, hear, or see something that jumps out, and I know this is my topic for the upcoming newsletter. I like to think it's The Holy Spirit moving in my life.

Today is the 20<sup>th</sup> of January, and I am sitting here with several books in front of me that I've been reading, and I'm not getting anything. Actually, that's not true. I am getting too much. Initially, I sat down ready to write about The Lord's Prayer, The Our Father, Section Two of the Catechism.

I went to get my Catechism and laying on top of it were the Bible and three other books I've been reading: "Introduction to the Devout Life," by St. Francis De Sales, "Making Sense Out



Of Suffering," by Peter Kreeft, and "holy moments," by Matthew Kelly. So now I want to talk about all three books, the Lord's Prayer, and the extraordinary bible versus I read this week. That would be a novel, not a newsletter article.

I am agitated and anxious as I pore over each book until a slip of paper drops out of one of them:

"Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit that my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit that my work too may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit that I love but what is holy.

Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit to defend all that is holy.

Guard me then, O Holy Spirit that I always may be holy. Amen."

Thank you, Lord for reminding me that I did not begin my work with prayer. Of course, the answer is Matthew Kelley's "Holy Moments." 'Holy' is repeated 10 times in the above prayer. "holy moments *A Handbook for the Rest of Your Life*" is free from <u>HolyMomentsBook.com</u>. You get 6 free books, shipping is \$23.00

This one little book has changed my life. Every day I see our country getting worse and I was frustrated because I wanted to do something, but what can one little nobody do. Well, Holy Moments showed me. Page. 99:

"Some ideas are so powerful that simply becoming aware of them changes our lives forever. Holy Moments is such an idea.

Once you hear about Holy Moments, the idea is impossible to forget. You cannot unhear it. It creates an immediate paradigm shift. Everywhere you go you will see opportunities to participate in Holy Moments..."

I will add, it teaches what one little nobody can do to change the world. You heard of the butterfly effect (the idea that a butterfly's wings might create tiny changes in the atmosphere that may ultimately alter the path of a tornado ).

Page 89: "You are just one person: (1). You teach 3 other people about Holy Moments: 1 + (1x3=3) = 4. And those 3 people teach 3 other people: 4 + (3x3=9) = 13. Those 9 teach 3 more: 13 + (9x3) = 40. And so it goes... It would take less than 21 cycles to reach the whole world's population. It's God's math. The principle of Spiritual Multiplication."

I haven't quite finished this article, and I decide <u>not</u> to submit it; to do something else. Suddenly I was interrupted by a phone call from John McAleer. This is our Retreat weekend at Malvern, but I couldn't go because of my back. John was letting me know that I could zoom into the retreat conferences, one of which was currently airing on Zoom. I stopped in the middle of this article to 'Zoom' in.

Father McHenry, retired pastor from St. Anthony of Padua, Ambler was talking about The Gifts of The Holy Spirit. Again, the Holy Spirit moving in my life. He ended by telling us to TRUST in the Lord. So, Lord, I do trust you, and here it is guys.
