Christ is Risen! Happy Easter!

In the summer of 1961, at age fifteen, I started working for a Master Cabinet Maker who taught me how to read a carpenter's rule. He was an artist at his craft. The beauty and precision of his cabinets made him in great demand.

It took me almost all of that first summer to understand those little ruler ticks. I easily grasped the inches, the half inches, and quarters, but the rest just wouldn't sink in.



One day the light went on and once I grasped the Eighth-inch ticks, the rest fell into place. When life knocks us down with those "surprises" like losing a job, the passing of a loved one, sickness, or whatever, it is difficult to see anything but what is right in front of us at the moment. All we can see is that 'surprise' and feel the hurt taking up our whole being, sucking the life out of us.

But what if we are only seeing 1/16, or 1/32, or 1/64 or... it could go on to infinity; smaller and smaller to the teensiest sliver. But how much of the whole picture are we seeing? At that moment, to us it is the whole picture. It is the only thing in the world that matters. We are in such great pain; suffering and sadness like never before. We are hurting so much, it is all one can think about and dwell on.

But in God's perfect plan it is only a very tiny bit of the whole picture. Maybe one-eighth of the whole picture (or 1/16, 1/32?) – The point is we can not see the whole picture, the entire puzzle. Who knows God's mind? (See IS 55, 8:9)

What if in our suffering, someone was to say that this 'surprise' is the best thing to happen to us? I'd probably want to hurt them. One would certainly think them cruel and uncaring, or just plain crazy. But if we could see the entire picture, we may be amazed at God's perfect plan and understand why this unhappy 'surprise' happened. Our sorrow would turn to joy and we would be exalted and humbled that God chose us.

God loves us dearly. His love for us is extravagant, excessive, lavish, and extreme. There is nothing he wouldn't do for us. If we can remember every 'bad' surprise that happens is for our good, we can thank the Lord and live much happier lives. God has never... and will never do anything but what is best for us. Saint James, the cousin of Jesus tells us to "count it all as joy when we meet various trials...that we may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." (JAS 1, 2)
