The cost is \$10.00 per ticket and gives you a chance to win 25 weekly cash prizes ranging from \$30 to \$400 that total \$3,000. Your ticket covers the last 10 weeks of the football season, so it actually comes down to \$1 per

Lecture Message

God's Mercy and Love

It is Monday, September 23, 2024, today as I write this. And just like every other year at this time I am writing this from our rental at Sea Isle City. Looking out over the ocean I remember St. Faustina's diary about God's Oceans of mercy.

I'm sitting here on the deck overlooking the ocean which is very calm compared to its thunderous stormy rage of the past week. The ocean currents slowly drift along



flowing where they do, following the path of least resistance, as if against its wishes, with no effort to change its course. It reminds me of our lives when it comes to choosing God.

We allow ourselves to drift almost mindlessly along our journey through life passively accepting "circumstances" either unconscious, unaware, or indifferent that we can make a different choice. It may even never occur to some that we do have a choice. We bury our heads in the sand so to speak. Everyone wants to be happy, but few make the conscious choice or effort to do so.

We allow the concerns of life, work, family, or presumed responsibilities to drive our thoughts and actions. Emotions mostly us rather than willful choice. It goes like this: "I just do not feel like praying right now, I'm too stressed, upset, or tired." You may not agree, but that is a choice. We are choosing the world, our emotions over God. We are saying, "God I know what you want, but I want what I want!" Use your gift of will and talk with God.

Sometimes we justify our disobedience; we say, "God understands, I can't go to Mass today because of this, that or some other believed excuse, but what we are really saying is "I want what I want not what you want, Lord." The sad part of this is we really don't understand that what God wants is our happiness. God is so good He allows our disobedience and betrayal yet still loves us.

What I'm trying to get at here is to understand that we are the masters of our minds, our thoughts, and our actions. We are not robots with programmed coding. We have the power to decide, the power to choose; The power of what thoughts to think or what action to take. We have the power to choose what we are going to do right at any given moment. Stop and be conscious of the moment. Stop to consider or think about what is happening and realize you are about to make a choice. Make it mindful or willful. Make it a conscious choice. Choose God.

God always gives us what we want. God always allows what we choose. Choose Him. Choose to come home into the loving waiting arms of your forgiving Father. No matter what you think is so evil, so underserving, so unforgiving, or so disappointing to deny His loving you, talk to Him about it. Tell him exactly what you are feeling, He loves to hear from you. If you wonder how God can love us sinners who betray Him, and think your sins are unforgivable, Read Isaiah 55:8-9, Luke 15:11-32, 2 Samuel 11, and 12:1-7 He says your sins are totally forgotten by him in Psalm 103. Talk to Him. God loves you and wants you just as you are, right here, right now at this very moment, and much, much more than you can possibly know.

Talk to God, Go to Him, Run to Him, His mercy [for you] endures forever.
